

# WorkFirst Eligibility Requirements

Must Be a Temporary Aid to Needy Families (TANF) Recipient Must Be Referred from a Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) Case Manager

Attendance Must Be Reported Weekly Through Canvas

# Basic Food Employment & Training (BFET) Eligibility Requirements







Must be Receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

CANNOT BE RECEIVING TANF

MONTHLY CHECK-INS WITH YOUR WORKFORCE NAVIGATOR IN CANVAS ARE REQUIRED

#### BFET can assist specific Academic Transfer Programs:

- Associate of Arts in Biology, Business, Computer Science, Music, Pre-nursing
- Associate of Science with specialization in Astronomy/Physics; Atmospheric Science; Biology; Chemistry;
   Computer Engineering; Earth Sciences; General Engineering; Environmental Sciences.
- Associate of Science in Bioengineering and Chemical Engineering, Computer Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical, Civil, Aeronautical, Industrial and Material Science Engineering

**Currently Collecting Unemployment** 

Collected Unemployment in the Last 4 Years

Discharged from Military Service in the Last 4 Years


Closed a State-licensed Business within the Last 4 Years

Became a Displaced Homemaker in the Last 4 Years and are Low-Income

Worker in Need of Skills Upgrade


Working in a Daycare or Pre-school that is Early Achiever Certified

Significant Documentation and Monthly Contact with Workforce Navigator is Required


