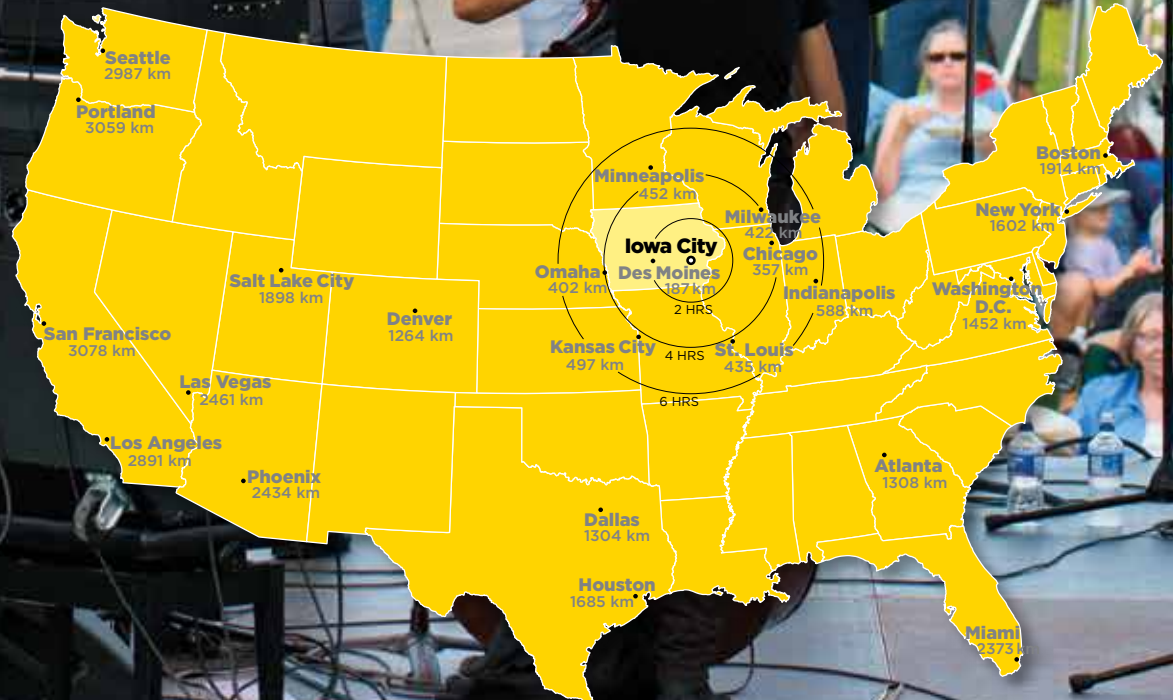

How to apply

- **Submit an online application** by visiting admissions.uiowa.edu/apply.
- **Upload transcripts** (college-level credit awarded for successful completion of AP, IB, GAC, AS, A-levels).
- **Report English proficiency.** Submit TOEFL or IELTS scores if your first language is not English. TOEFL minimum is 80 with no subscore less than 17. IELTS minimum is 65 with no band score less than 6.0.
- **ACT/SAT scores** are optional for most colleges, but encouraged for scholarship purposes.
- Letters of recommendation and essays are **NOT** required.
- **Complete your financial statement** (students requesting F1 or J1 status).
- **After admission:**
- **Receive your admission & scholarship notification.** Merit-based scholarships are available to qualified applicants.
- **Apply for housing early.**
- **Accept admission** and pay your enrollment deposit.
- **Complete eShipGlobal to receive immigration documents** if you reside outside the United States.
- **Complete the pre-arrival checklist** through International Student and Scholar Services.
- Register for and attend **student orientation** and **Onlwa!**
- **Start classes!**
