


The University is located in a quiet and safe residential neighborhood in San Francisco with public transportation to all parts of the city and beyond.

Rankings & Distinctions

In a region known for innovation, creativity and progressive thinking, SF State is the intellectual heart and soul of the surrounding city. Acknowledged as a leader in community service learning and international education, SF State is also a major civic force, partnering with government, business and educational leaders to advance both the University and the region.

- The Center for Computing in Life Sciences at SF State conducts LEADING-EDGE RESEARCH in such areas as bioinformatics, data modeling and computational drug discovery by integrating life sciences, computational science and mathematics.
- Recognized by the Aspen Institute as ONE OF THE WORLD'S TOP BUSINESS SCHOOLS integrating social and environmental issues into its curriculum, SF State was the first California State University campus to offer an MBA with an emphasis in sustainability accredited by the Association for the Advancement of Collegiate Schools of Business.
- SF State's Broadcast and Electronic Communications (Radio & TV) department is ONE OF THE LARGEST AND MOST INFLUENTIAL PROGRAMS of its kind in the Western U.S.
- SF State's Physical Therapy Master's program has been consistently ranked ONE OF THE TOP 20 PROGRAMS in the country by U.S. News & World Report.
- SF State was the FIRST UNIVERSITY TO OFFER A DEGREE IN INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS, and the program remains among the top 15 nationwide.
- SF State is a NEW TRAINING GROUND FOR FUTURE STEM CELL RESEARCH, with support from a \$1.7 million grant from the California Institute of Regenerative Medicine. The University's new stem cell biology training program prepares scientists for the leading edge of stem cell research.









Admission Requirements

UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS (BACHELOR'S DEGREE)

- Complete a high/secondary school curriculum which totals 12 years of primary-secondary education.
- Earn a graduation diploma or certificate.
- Minimum average of grades/ marks/scores should equal a 2.5 grade point average (GPA) in the 4.0 grading scale; some majors require a higher GPA.
- Required minimum
 TOEFL iBT 61 or IELTS 6.0
- An official transcript (academic record) from all schools/institutions attended showing completion of courses with examinations or grades
- Transfer credit from accredited colleges/universities is given upon SF State evaluation of transcripts.

- Official transcript and certificate/ diplomas must be in the original language of issue; submit certified English translations for non-English documents.
- Financial Statement showing cost of studying and living for one year
- Medical Health Insurance agreement
- Application fee \$55 U.S.

APPLICATION FILING PERIODS

FALL SEMESTER (Aug.-Dec.): October 1-May 1

SPRING SEMESTER (Jan.–May): August 1–September 30

<u>Some majors</u> have earlier deadlines, additional admission requirements and do not offer spring admission.

GRADUATE/POST-GRADUATE ADMISSIONS (MASTER'S, PhD, EdD DEGREES)

- Hold a degree or diploma that SF State considers to be equivalent to a U.S. bachelor's degree from a government recognized or regionally accredited institution.
- An official transcript (academic record) from all institutions attended; an official academic document is a verification of your academic record issued directly from the university.
- Official transcript and certificate/ diplomas must be in the original language of issue; submit certified English translations for non-English documents.
- Minimum average of grades/ marks/scores should equal a 3.0 grade point average (GPA)

- in the 4.0 grading scale; some majors require a higher GPA.
- Required minimum TOEFL iBT 80, IELTS 7.0 or PTE 6.5; some majors require higher scores.
- Personal statement and letters of recommendation
- Certain majors require GRE or GMAT.
- Financial statement showing cost of studying and living for one year
- Medical heath insurance agreement

DEGREE/PROGRAM OFFERINGS

SF State awards bachelor's degrees in 78 academic areas with an additional 46 areas of concentration and master's degrees in 62 academic areas with an additional 42 areas of concentration. The University offers an independent Doctor of Education (EdD) in Educational Leadership as well as a PhD in education with a concentration in special education, jointly with University of California, Berkeley. In addition, SF State offers jointly with University of California, San Francisco an MS in physical therapy leading to a clinical doctoral degree (DPT) and a research doctorate for licensed physical therapists (DPTSc).
