## Fall Quarter Checklist



- **Know your Student ID number.**

Check your official “Welcome to TCC” email for your student number, then visit [Set Up TCC Accounts](#) to get started. Can’t find your Student ID number or forgot your password? Try [eLearning Support](#).

- **Login to ctcLink.**

- **Check your Financial Aid in your ctcLink Student Account.**

Carefully read and follow instructions. If you’re missing any documents, you can [upload documents](#) or turn them in to the drop box outside of Bldg. 14. Questions about your financial aid status? Contact the [Financial Aid Office](#) right away.

- **Check your tech.**

Need a computer? [Check out a laptop online](#), then pick it up in the Library or the Info Commons.

- **Get to know Canvas, your online classroom.**

In-person classes have Canvas pages too! Here’s a [video](#) to help you get started.

- **Get your books.**

[Order your books online](#) and pick them up in-store. Many TCC classes use Open Educational Resources (OER) instead of traditional textbooks. The Bookstore may be able to print your OER materials for a small fee.

- **Get your Parking Pass.**

[Register your vehicle online](#), then go to the Bldg. 14 Campus Public Safety Office to get your pass to display in your vehicle.

- **Get your FREE Pierce Transit ORCA Bus Pass.**

You only need to [apply once](#) – the pass is good for as long as you’re enrolled at TCC.

- **Map out your academic support system.**

Need help with a Math Class? Get to know the Math Advising Resource Center (MARC) in Bldg. 19. Need help with a paper? Go to the Writing & Tutoring Center, upstairs in Bldg. 7. Need academic sources for your paper? Head on over to the Library, downstairs in Bldg. 7. [Find resources here](#).

- **Make sure your needs are covered.**

- **Stay COVID Safe.**
