 - iv. BUS100 was Business English; now it is Business Communications
 - v. The only students taking this course will be at DOC facilities, so it does not need to be published in the catalog.
 - vi. No PLO's are required for courses at DOC facilities
 - vii. These changes need to be made so TCC can count the FTE's at these facilities
 - viii. S. Ashpole will clean up the coding issue.

- **ix.** A non-credit Accuplacer preparation course might be offered with a cost of \$18.

• Curricunet Update:

- The developmental phase has concluded

- We are nearing the maintenance phase of Curricunet
- In the there will be additional training on Curricunet for those who need it
- o In the fall we will begin a pilot testing for the Degree Outcomes
- C. Gore may do the first pilot testing for the HIM program
- The syllabus module within Curricunet is ready to use
- Some information is automatically pre-populated from the Curricunet data
- This format matches the TCC syllabus template
- Committee Reorganization and Assignments:
 - o Not all campus departments/programs are currently being represented
 - o Some new/different assignment will occur in the 2011-2012 academic year
 - Because of budget cuts and reorganization of workloads across campus, the Curriculum Committee will have limited clerical support
 - Curriculum Committee members will assume frontline responsibilities for addressing faculty questions about course proposal protocol within Curricunet
 - B. Peterson and K. Rzeszewicz will be secondary sources on a limited basis.
 - A Curriculum Committee/Curricunet manual may be developed this fall
