CHP 335 - Healthcare Research Methods	5	5	Winter	2020	Change credit load to 5 credits. Modification to course learning outcomes and catalog description.	The main purpose of this class is to provide a broad introduction to the methodological foundations and tools to study healthcare research. This course will focus on the fundamentals of quantitative healthcare and applied research, and explore qualitative research. Students will learn how to identify problems to study, develop hypotheses and research questions, specify independent and dependent variables, check for the validity and reliability of studies and design research projects. Students will be exposed to the broad range of designs used in healthcare research from laboratory and field experiments, surveys, content analysis, focus groups and in-depth interviewing.

ENGR 170 - Introduction to Materials Science	5	5	Winter	2020	Course Reactivation. TCC has not offered this course in many years as a result of prioritization of limited resources. This course will fill the gap to our current Associate of Science MRP degrees, specifically Mechanical Engineering and Materials Science, and it will help students majoring in these fields and engineering field in general to be more prepared for transfer. It should be noted that this course is required for graduation in some engineering programs, e.g. Materials Science, Mechanical Engineering. In this course modification proposal, the catalog description and credit hours have been updated and adjusted to fit requirements of similar courses offered at major four-year universities in Washington State.  Prerequisite: CHEM& 162 (may be taken concurrently) and MATH& 141	Fundamental principles of structures and properties of materials used in engineering practice. Topics covered in this course include structures-properties relationship, imperfections of materials, diffusion, phase equilibrium and transformation, and application and processing of materials in engineering practice. Metal, ceramics, polymeric, and composite materials. Mechanical, chemical, and electrical properties of materials.

Human Services Professional	Associate in Applied Sciences	Summer	2019	<p>Updates for the HSP Associates in Applied Sciences degree are being made so we can publish these elements in the 2019-2020 catalog. The updates are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In the description adding a note that a grade of C or better is required for all courses required for the degree and certificates is added so we can publish this requirement in the catalog (this is not a new requirement but want to put it in the catalog so the students have the information several places)</li> <li>2. Dropping the two credit CU 102 Word course from HSP degree requirements. The HSP 126 Cultural Competencies in Human Services is a total online course and embedded in the course materials are instructions and practice opportunities that students learn and use throughout this course. The CU 102 course material is repetitious based on the computer technology learned and used in HSP 126.</li> <li>3. Dropping HSP 130 – Recovery Education from the list of HSP Specialty Courses. This course was originally created for a very specialized program we had in collaboration with Department of Corrections (DOC). Because of funding issues DOC cancelled the program after one year. This course is very basic in content and not a relevant learning for our current students.</li> <li>4. Adding HSP 218 – Trauma Informed Care to the list of specialty courses offered by the program. This course was approved last year but never added to the program list of specialty courses.</li> </ol>

Adding verbiage to clarify that all 45 credits of this certificate must be earned at TCC to ensure students are meeting the 23 competencies required by the Washington Department of Health.</p> <p>Updates for the Chemical Dependency Certificate are being made so we can publish this information in the 2019-2020 catalog. The updates are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Change the Human Services Certificate to Chemical Dependency Certificate. This name change was made two years ago to reflect what the certificate actually covers. Many people come to TCC just to earn this certificate so they can apply for the state certification. The name change has been made on all relevant college forms but not in the college catalog.</li> <li>2. The added verbiage in the description matches the information in the WAC. This reference makes a clear statement of what is required by the state.</li> </ol>
