Based on our call with NWCCU (James Wagner) on 6/28/2018, we entered the following into the Annual Report.

For Institutional Finances

Expenses \$73,139,912 (which is the Total expenses and deductions for C-1 line 19 of the IPEDS Report)

For Graduation Rates

We entered our graduation rate into the four-year institution to match IPEDS submissions. For the purposes of IPEDS, once we started accepting students into BAS degrees we now report our graduation rate on the 150% of 4 years.

For Significant Growth in programs
