Memorandum of Understanding Tacoma Community College (TCC) and TCC Federation of Teachers

2021–22 Faculty Advisor – Phi Theta Kappa (PTK)

The Tacoma Community College (College), and the Tacoma Community College Federation of Teachers (Union), agree to the following memorandum of understanding.

For the academic year 2021-22:

- 1. The primary advisor for PTK will be given release for one (1) class per quarter. The primary PTK advisor will not be eligible for a PAU.
- 2. The secondary PTK advisor will be eligible for PAUs as described in article 8.71 (b)(3) Student Clubs.
- 3. If the primary PTK advisor is unable to perform the full duties and responsibilities of club advisor and the secondary PTK advisor assumes full duties and responsibilities of club advisor, then the secondary PTK advisor will be given release for one (1) class per quarter. At no time will one (1) class release per quarter be awarded to more than one (1) faculty.
- 4. For the 2021-22 year, the primary PTK club advisor will be provided a stipend for the Fall and Winter quarter equivalent to the value of one (1) class per quarter. For Spring quarter 2022, the primary advisor for the PTK will be given release for one (1) class.

This MOU recognizes the level of work needed to support student members that meet twice per week, participate in Fall/Winter/International/Honor Conference, and maintain 5-Star PTK Club Rank.

This memorandum of understanding will be in force beginning with the 2021-22 academic year and expires on June 30, 2022.
