PRECOLLEGE ENGLISH SCORECARD AT A GLANCE: *Change in Percentage Points Earned by Demographic*

This quarter's newsletter focuses on TCC's Student Achievement Initiative (SAI) precollege English milestone. Precollege milestone points are points awarded to students that successfully complete a college-level math or English/communication course AND they had taken a precollege math or English course in the current or prior year. The emphasis and the focus is not on completion of a precollege course or sequence but rather on the successful transition from developmental courses to college courses. The newsletter delves into the change in the percentage of precollege milestone points earned by different student demographics from 2018-2019 to 2019-2020.

Benchmarking to Washington's 33 community and technical colleges, TCC ranked second in earning precollege English points. The college has maintained this rank since 2018-2019 academic year.
