- I received Federal PELL Grant during the 2019-2020 school year, will be attending Summer 2020 and would like to receive Federal PELL Grant for summer. **Year Round Federal PELL Grant:** If you have used 100% of 2019-2020 Federal PELL Grant eligibility (attended full time fall, winter, spring) you may be eligible to receive additional Federal PELL Grant if you are enrolled in at least 6 credits that are required for your TCC program. Students who received Federal PELL Grant during 2019-2020 and are enrolled for 5 or fewer credits may be eligible to receive the remainder of their Federal PELL Grant eligibility if they did not attend full time all three terms during 2019-2020.
- I received the **College Bound Scholarship (CBS)** during the 2019-2020 school year and will be enrolled for Summer 2020. You must be enrolled for a minimum of **3 credits** to receive 25% eligibility of award.
- I will earn my degree/certificate in August 2020 by completing my summer course work. I understand that this will be my final term receiving aid at TCC. **Advisor recommendation required** (see back of form).
- I **have been formally accepted** into a professional technical program that **requires** summer attendance. Check your program below. Please be aware that if you were not eligible for aid during the 2019-2020 school year, you will likely not be eligible to receive aid during the summer. Funds are limited.
